



This ancient knowledge was woven into the fabric of mythology and became embedded in the traditions of kingship and sovereignty, for it was the task of monarchs to symbolically reflect the heavenly harmony and order of the wider cosmos and bring it down to Earth.

England's Queen Elizabeth I was a notable example of this link between sovereignty and the heavenly sphere. Called Astraea, the Star Maiden, by her inner circle, her court astrologer Dr. John Dee was one of the world's leading experts on starlore, cosmology and meridians at that time.

Like Henry VII and his son Henry VIII, the Tudors were well-versed in ancient mythology and aligned themselves with the power of the stars. It is not surprising that Greenwich was their favourite Royal Palace, set at the centre of the Axis Mundi.

The Royal Orb and Royal Rod or Sceptre which play such an important role in kingship ceremonies are symbolic of the World and the Polar Axis, signifying the ancient authority of the sovereign over their earthly kingdom.



Given the true age of many of the sites linked to the Greenwich Meridian the authors conclude that the original creation of this Axis may well go back to the time of Stonehenge, when ancient astronomers set in stone their understanding of the cosmos. They also, according to these latest discoveries, laid out a Polar Axis, or what we call today a meridian, in the landscape of eastern England, leaving behind a legacy that has influenced the whole world.
